End-of-Course Examination Program (EOCEP)

Beginning with the Fall/Winter 2018-19 administration, the English 1 Writing section must be administered within the district's 15-day testing window in the same manner as the other four EOCEP tests. The designated Writing dates have been eliminated.

<u>EOCEP tests</u>—For each administration, DTCs will select a 15-day testing window within the state-approved testing windows shown below. The 15-day district testing window for fall or spring semester-long courses must not begin before the 75th instructional day. For year-long courses the 15-day district testing window must not begin before the 165th instructional day.

<u>English 2 Field Test</u>— With the exception of students who take alternate assessments, the English 2 field tests must be administered to:

- Students who are enrolled in a credit-bearing English 2 course (year-round or spring semester).
- Students who are in their second year or above of high school, whose projected high school outcomes are non-diploma, and who are enrolled in an English 2 aligned course.

Like the English 1 test, the English 2 field test will consist of separate writing and reading sections. Testing and make-up testing for the English 2 writing and reading field tests must be administered within the district's 15-day testing window. Students will not receive scores for the spring 2019 English 2 field test.

<u>Scoring for English 1—</u>For online testing, the reading section of the English 1 test will be scored within 36 hours, however, handscoring of the TDA essay, on the writing section, requires ten days. The English 1 score will be posted ten days after the writing responses are submitted or 36 hours after the reading responses are submitted, whichever date is latest.
