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Per Governor McMaster's order, the Marion County School District will be closed for students March 16-March 31. The information below is to provide families with information that will assist them in understanding the various aspects of the closure. During the time of closure, all after school activities and sporting events are canceled until further notice and information concerning rescheduling will be released when it becomes available.

The District has closed all school buildings to all and any visitors. Therefore, during instructional packet pick up there will be no entry into buildings. Modified Instructional Plans and lesson packets for our students at Mullins High School will be available for pick up by parents or students at the front door Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am-12:00 pm. The expectation for students will be to complete all and any work assigned to them by their classroom teachers, which will be in each student's packet. The work will need to be turned in for grading to their teachers upon the re-opening of the schools. Each teacher will be available via email Monday-Friday from 9:00 am-12:00 pm to answer any question you or your child may have for a particular class. Parents or students will only be able to contact the school by use of telephone only during the school closure from 8:00 am-10:00 am Monday –Friday.

Although we cannot replace the value of a live classroom teacher that provides for direct student interaction, we know that continued instruction is important and ask that our stakeholders trust and support our educators as they adjust to a modified teaching and learning process. Please continue to check our district and school webpages for further instructional guidance. We do ask parents to commit to adhering to the expectations of the Learning Packet. We recognize that this is a huge undertaking and will require tremendous effort from all; however the district will be working closely with parents and will make this unique situation the best possible experience for our students. If you have any questions or concerns pertaining to an individual circumstance, please contact the school during the above designated time.
