

Discover a new career. Become an educator.

If you have a bachelor's degree and are interested in becoming a teacher, a new opportunity is available that may allow you to do so quickly with a living stipend. Earn a master's degree in teaching while spending a yearlong residency in a school gaining valuable teaching experience. Secure employment as a new teacher in the school district at a higher pay scale.



Through the CU-PREPARES U.S. Department of Education grant program, partner school districts with Clemson will offer an entirely online Master of Arts in Teaching degree with certification. School districts will employ participating students at the completion of their MAT degree. Districts include **Darlington, Florence 1, Florence 3, Georgetown and Marion County School Districts.**

The grant will allow aspiring teachers to become a teacher while receiving a \$25,000 living stipend **while they spend a yearlong residency in a classroom coteaching with a mentor teacher.** Participating students may also be eligible for the SC Teacher Loan and Forgiveness Program. After earning their MAT, students commit to teach in the participating district for three years. Candidates will begin coursework in May and finish in June of the following year with an August graduation date. The following degree programs are available:

Teacher candidates must meet requirements for admission into the MAT program—2.75 GPA (3.0 preferred) and content courses required for certification (C or better)—and must meet requirements for student teaching clearance. 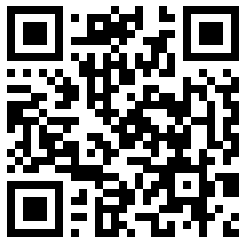

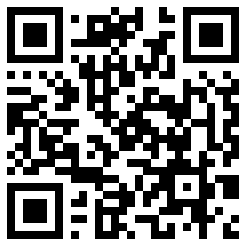

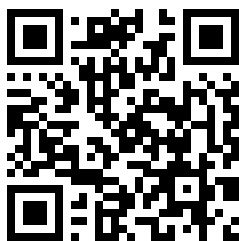
