Dear Parent/Guardian of JMS Scholar:

An important goal set by Johnakin Middle School is to ensure that all of our students achieve academic success. Reading at grade level and having a solid foundation in mathematics skills is essential for succeeding in school as well as beyond. Therefore, we will be providing opportunities for our students to engage in interventions based on their specific areas of need. Your child could receive additional instruction for 75 minutes daily, Monday thru Thursday beginning February 3, 2020, during our afterschool program.

Your child has the opportunity to receive additional instruction from our ELA and/or math instructors in the after school program, ***Fox Time After Hours, from 3:30 PM – 4:45 PM.*** Please note, you will be responsible for providing transportation for your child.

The interventions are designed to help students succeed on the SCREADY assessment beginning in May 2020. SCREADY is the state standardized assessment used to measure what your child has learned all year. Your child was chosen for this intervention based on his/her 2019 SCREADY scores in the areas of math and reading. His/her performance level was “Approaches” on the assessment in one or both areas. We feel with additional support, your child will move to the “Meets” performance level.

We will also operate a Homework Center. Your child will be able to make up classwork assignments or get assistance with homework. We consider your student’s academic achievement in school a top priority. This intervention is designed to improve academic success.
